**Focus:** Our skilled nursing facility is divided into two units; a sub-acute unit and a long-term care unit. Our associates are caring and create a loving home-like environment for 89 residents.

**RN to patient ratio for each shift:** Day 1:5-7, Evening 1:5-7; Night 1:20-24 (+ 1-2 LPNs on each shift)

**Uniforms required:** Royal Blue scrubs for RNs and Ceil Blue for Techs. (Associate purchases.)

**Orientation to the unit lasts 3-4 days.**

**Orientation to the unit occurs on 2 shifts.**

**Other comments specific to the unit:**

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Our facility functions with mostly LPNs, 1 RN on each shift.
