



Fact Sheet for: Imaging Nursing

Current as of 02/08

Focus/Mission of department: Prep and recover patients for invasive procedures performed in the Imaging Department. Administer conscious sedation during invasive procedures. Provide nursing care to all patients in the Imaging Department in support of the Technologists and Radiologists.

Description of services provided: Assessments, start IV's, administer medications, pt and family education, discharge teaching, follow up calls to pts, make rounds on in-house pts.

Hours of operation: 6:30am – 7pm, Monday thru Friday
Call required on week nights and weekends.

Locations of GHS that service is performed: GMC, GOC, JGMH, and 575 OIC.

RN to patient ratio for each shift: 1:1 during procedures and 1:2 in recovery room.

Special Equipment used in department: dash4000 monitor and Marquette monitor Doppler

Medical conditions for ref/care in department: CA, DVT, PE, Renal impairment, Uterine Fibroids, Pts needing vascular access

Resources available in crisis: Nursing Supervisor, Charge Nurse, Department Manager, Service Line Director, Code Team, Respiratory Therapists

Scheduling rotations for planning for shifts: 8 or 10 hour shifts

Points of differentiation (ex. different from competition): 10 bed Imaging Nursing Unit, 2 Angio suites

Uniforms required: Royal Blue scrubs for RNs and Ceil Blue for Techs. (Associate purchases.)
