Scope of Patient Care/Services:

The Outpatient Treatment Center is under Oncology Services. Patients vary in age from infant to adult requiring infusion or injection therapy as an outpatient. Services provided include: chemotherapy administration, IVIG (immunoglobulin) administration, Remicade infusion for rheumatoid arthritis, chrons disease and other approved diagnosis. Also provided are Intravenous antibiotics, Intravenous fluids for patients requiring hydration, Tysabri infusions for multiple sclerosis. Injections of antibiotics, procrit, neupogen, neulasta, Rabies vaccinations, Vitamin B-12, Vitamin K, Rhogam and others are provided as well.
