Focus of unit: Plans, prepares and coordinates care of the patient undergoing various types of surgery, to include outpatient procedures.

RN to patient ratio for each shift: One team consisting of at least 1 RN plus one scrub person (RN or Surgical Technician)

Average # (cases/patients) per day at GMC-D : 20

Number of beds in unit: Inpatient facilities- 3 GMC-Duluth OR; Gwinnett Outpatient facilities connected by corridor.

Special equipment used in the department: Myriad of technological diverse equipment-Updated, instrumentation, tables, drills, integrated video system, with equipment management, image guided technology, PACS, etc.

Patients admitted to the unit from: Home, floor, ED, ICU

Services provided for patients in the unit: Orthopedic, ENT, Vascular, Plastics, General,

Resources available in unit during a crisis: Surgeon, Anesthesia staff including MD, Respiratory Therapy, PACU Nursing and Ancillary staff including patient representative and Chaplain.

RN's are required to work: Call required and will be rotated.
