Focus of unit: In Patient Rehabilitation Unit (IRU)

RN to patient ratio for each shift: Day 1:6 Evening 1:6 Night 1:10

Tech to patient ratio: Day 1:7.5 or 4:30 Evening 1:10 Night 1:10

Number of beds in unit: 30 **Average length of stay:** 7-10 days, up to 4 weeks

Patients admitted to the unit from: GMC, GMCD, Area Hospitals

Medical conditions of patients in the unit: The Rehab patients are orthopedic and neurologic. Specializes in the treatment of neurologic and orthopedic impairments including strokes, traumatic brain injury, multiple trauma, hip fracture, and joint replacement.

Unit uses Omnicell and SureMed. ARJO Lift System

RNs are required to work every other weekend.

RNs in the unit cover every other holiday **per year.**

Uniforms required: Royal Blue scrubs for RNs and Ceil Blue for Techs. (Associate purchases.)

Orientation to the unit lasts? Individually tailored.

Orientation to the unit occurs? Begins on days and then continues on the shift the nurse will work.

Other comments specific to the unit:

Glancy Rehab Center is a 30-bed, CARF accredited program that offers treatment for a variety of diagnoses, including neurologic and orthopedic impairments, such as traumatic brain injury, stroke, Guillian Barre Syndrome, multiple trauma, hip fracture and joint replacement. More than 90% of our patients return home to their community after discharge.

Nurses are a vital part of our interdisciplinary treatment team. As a member of the Rehab team, you will work with other team members to develop an individualized plan of recovery for each patient. Team members include physical and occupational therapist, speech language pathologists, therapeutic recreation specialist, case managers, our medical director-a physician who specializes in rehabilitation and a board certified physiatrist.

The Glancy Rehabilitation Center is located in Duluth. The center features a dayroom, a fully equipped therapy gym with skylights for natural lighting, and activities of daily living area. Our outside patio is designed with a variety of surfaces for use during therapy. The therapeutic gardening area and putting green provide clients with an opportunity to practice leisure skills or relax with their family during visiting hours.
