

**MEDICARE OUTPATIENT
CO-INSURANCE NOTICE**

To Our Medicare Patients at the Center for Cancer Care - Snellville:

This facility is operated as an outpatient department affiliated with Gwinnett Medical Center. As an outpatient department of the hospital, it is considered to be a provider-based department. As a receiver of services at this facility, you are a patient of Gwinnett Medical Center (Gwinnett Hospital System, Inc.).

Medicare regulations require us to provide you with a notice of your potential financial liability for the hospital service(s) you will receive. Your co-insurance liability for hospital services is separate from the Medicare co-insurance liability that you may owe for the physician service provided to you in conjunction with these hospital services.

We are required to advise you that because a department of the hospital furnishes the services, you will incur a co-insurance liability to the hospital that you would otherwise not incur if the services were furnished in an entity that is not hospital-based.

When you meet with our Benefits Counselor, you will be provided a full explanation of the expected co-insurance amount that you will owe throughout your care. The actual amount of your co-insurance may be different from the estimate because actual co-insurance liability is subject to services received and final determination by the Medicare program.

If you are enrolled in the state medical assistance program, Georgia Medicaid, your co-insurance liability may be reduced or eliminated by law. Be sure you have provided us a copy of your Medicaid card.

I have read the foregoing and understand that I will incur a liability to the hospital for Medicare co-insurance as permitted by law.
